  - Will put outfield fences up closer to the start of the season.
  - o Jesse will need some help to clean the concession stand.
- <u>Village work</u> (need receipts) or pay 500\$ park fee this year /<u>Vote</u>
  - Motion: Elissa Spangler, Seconded: Jesse Poston, unanimous board vote to pay the Village of Amanda \$500
    - Discussion was had about park improvements. The Village has already repaired the fence and removed the slide. We could plant in the flower bed around the flagpole, but it is too early in the season.

## Portable restrooms (3 total)

 Decision was made to get rid of the 2 in Amanda at the end of March and keep 2 in Stoutsville for the season.
