This meeting was called to change the age guidelines voted on at the December 15, 2022 meeting.

1. Meeting began with a review of what was discussed at the previous meeting. We had set age guidelines based on a child's grade in school, with the exclusion of T-Ball being May 1, 2023. Jed discussed this with both the LGSA (softball league) and MSYL (baseball league) boards. Darren from LGSA stated that softball must use January 1, 2023 as the cutoff date per ASA rules. MSYL representatives stated that they are an age-based team and we could not use grade levels to build our teams.
2. It was agreed that we must use January 1, 2023 as our cutoff date for softball to align with the LGSA.
3. Lengthy discussion was held about potential age guidelines for t-ball and baseball. The following was decided:
 - a. T-ball would use May 1, 2023 as the cutoff. Meaning a player must be 4 by May 1st of this year to play in the MOYL. The oldest a t-ball player could be is 6 by May 1st.
 - b. Baseball would use May 1, 2023 as the cutoff date. This means a player must be 7 by May 1st of this year to play in the baseball league.
4. If a player is 6 years old they can play baseball in 8U under the following conditions:
 - a. They have played 1 year of t-ball
 - b. They attend an assessment to be arranged by the MOYL.
 - c. These players will need to attend an in-person registration date as the Team Sideline system will not allow them to enroll in the 8U baseball program.

Motion made by Andrea and seconded by Tony to adopt these age guidelines for t-ball, baseball, and softball. All were in favor.
