1. Old Business:

- Shirt Fundraiser- Hover Apparel will create flyer and website, we get a 2-week window to order from site. Andrea and Jared will manage. Motion by Matt Poston, seconded by Brent Poston, unanimous vote by the board to proceed with shirt fundraiser.

- Bw3 Cards- Linsey is calling for details and will provide at February meeting. Motion by Brent Poston, seconded by Jesse Poston, unanimous vote by the board to proceed with gathering details.
- Park Cleanup Day – Saturday, March 19, 2022 at 8:00 a.m., meet at Amanda ball park. Elissa will work with AC high school to find volunteers. Will do Amanda and Stoutsville the same day. Possible gear and equipment exchange the same day. Natalie to gather and provide more details on gear and equipment exchange. Elissa Spangler made a motion, seconded by Natalie Mesler. - T-Ball - Plans for season
 - Seth provided options:
 - Option 1.
 - Major/Minor Division (we could always call it Triple A or Majors)
 - "Major" players are either 6 years old or have played a year of t-ball with MOYL already.

- “Major” players would play other Amanda teams in addition to BC.
- “Major” & “Minor” players need to have structure on the field and structured coaches. Meaning play assigned positions, attentive/safe coaching, and have 1 to 2 practices throughout the week during the season.
- “Major” players have less leeway while on field. While we would go through the full lineup in each inning, players are guaranteed three pitches before the tee, and follow the BC rules we briefly discussed. I can elaborate on the two if needed.

Option 2.

- No Major/Minor division
 - Keep the same structure as last year and assign teams with a diversified amount of ages and skill level.
 - Option 2 if more of open introduction for players/coaches.
 - Keep schedule in house and play Amanda teams only.
